Admonish - appears 3 times * Admonishing - 1 time * Admonished - 5 times * Admonition - 3 times

- 1** - To reprove gently but earnestly
- 2** - To counsel (another) against something to be avoided; caution
- 3** - To remind of something forgotten or disregarded, as an obligation or a responsibility

II - We are to highly love & esteem the man of God who does this work {**1 Thess 5:12-13**}

III - Instructions for church discipline {**2 Thess 3:11-15**}

IV - We are fools who refuse admonition! {**Eccl 4:13**}

V - The sermons that the preacher delivers is for this purpose {**Eccl 12:8-12**}

VI - Certain Bible stories are written for this reason {**1 Cor 10:10-11**}

VII - We are to use this with our children {**Eph 6:4**}
