"He That Is Mighty Hath Done To Me Great Things"

Text: Luke 1:26-49

Intro:

➤ What we have expounded here in our passage this morning is one of the greatest Bible doctrine of them all, the virgin birth.

- > But what I want to focus on this morning is the statement that Mary made in **verse 49**.
- Mary made this statement after her cousin, Elizabeth had reaffirmed what previously the angel Gabriel had told her.
- ➤ How she would give birth to a son without knowing man, whose Father would be the Holy Ghost.
- Her son would be called Jesus, the Son of the Highest and the Lord God would give Him the throne of David.
- ➤ He would reign over Israel and His kingdom would have no end.
- When Mary made the statement "For he that is mighty hath done to me great things; and holy is his name" she realized just what a might God she served.
- > I want to preach awhile from our text on "For he that is mighty hath done to me great things;"
- ➤ I want us to look at some of the **Great Things** the Lord has done for us.

I. He Saved Us!

□ By His Grace -

✓ **Ephesians 2:8-9,** "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast."

□ By His Name -

✓ Acts 4:12 – "Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved."

□ By His Blood -

- ✓ 1 Peter 1:18-19 "Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:"
- ✓ Acts 20:28 "Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood."

□ By His Word -

✓ **1 Peter 1:23 –** "Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever."

□ To The Uttermost -

✓ Hebrews 7:25 – "Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them."

II. He Secures or Seals Us

- □ What good is it being saved if you can loose your salvation?
 - √ We Can't Be Separated See Romans 8:38-39
 - √ We Can't Be Plucked See John 10:28-30
 - √ We Can't Be Unsealed See Ephesians 4:30

III. He Made Us His Son with all the Benefits

- □ He Gave Us Power to Become His Son John 1:12
- □ He Gave Us His Spirit Romans 8:14, 16
- □ He Adopted Us Romans 8:15
- □ He Made Us His Heirs Romans 8:17-18

IV. He Seated Us

- □ In Heavenly Places Ephesians 2:6
 - ✓ Because We Are Seated In Heavenly Places
 - We are blessed with all spiritual blessings
 - **Ephesians 1:3,** "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:"
 - ✓ Because We Are Seated In Heavenly Places
 - We make know to the angels the manifold wisdom of God.
 - Ephesians 3:10, "To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God."
