Giving Thanks to God

Text: Colossians 3:17

- I. Thank Him IN Everything
- "In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you" (I Thess. 5:18).
- A. Many people thank God in good times but fail to thank Him when the going gets rough.
- B. Some Christians are selfishly motivated. They put their own desires ahead of God's. We must give Him first place (Matt. 6:33).
- C. We should seek God's will and heed Paul's advice: "In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God .(I Thess. 5:18).
- II. Thank Him FOR Everything
 - "Giving thanks always for all things unto God (Eph. 5:20).
- A. Many Christians are ready to thank God for the good but not the bad things that happen to them.
- B. God may not send the bad, but He sometimes allows it to come to fulfill His purpose.
- C. We should thank God for all things, knowing that He works everything together for our good and His glory (Rom. 8:28).
- III. Thank Him WITH Everything
- "Praise him with the sound of the trumpet Let everything that hath breath praise the LORD (Ps. 150:3, 6).
- A. People often do not thank God with everything.
- B. We must show our thanks to God by putting everything we are and own at His disposal, including our time, talent, and treasure.
- C. The more we give, the more He will supply, for if we give, the more He will do for us (Luke 6:38).
- IV. Thank Him THROUGH Everything
- "If any man suffer as a Christian... let him glorify God on this behalf" (I Peter 4:16).
- A. Some Christians thank God while going through mountain-top experiences but fail to thank Him while traversing the valleys.
- B. God allows testing, trial, and temptation to expand our faith and take us deeper in His love.
- C. "Concerning the fiery trial," Peter advised, "But rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Christ's sufferings; that, when his glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy" (I Peter 4:12-13).
