- o People have their definitions of what it means to be blessed.
  - Often based on material possessions.
- o The world has their definition of what it means to be blessed and so doesn't God.
  - I don't know about you but I could careless what the world thinks.
  - I am more interested in knowing what God thinks about a matter.
  - We can know what God thinks about a thing by going to His inspired, inerrant, infallible, preserved words, the AV1611, King James Bible.
  - That is exactly what we want to do this morning.
  - We want to find from the Word of God what it means to blessed and just how one is blessed.
- **Definition**: Made happy or prosperous; extolled; pronounced happy.
  - Happy; prosperous in worldly affairs; enjoying spiritual happiness and the favor of God; enjoying heavenly felicity.
