## SOME RIGHT DIVISIONS

#### I. THE SEVEN BAPTISMS

- 1) A baptism "unto Moses" in a cloud and the sea (I Corinthians 10:1-2).
  - 2) A water baptism of John the Baptist to manifest Christ to Israel (John 1:31).
- 3) Peter's water Baptism for Israel (Acts 2:38) in the "name of Jesus".
  - 4) A baptism of physical suffering (Matthew 20:22-23)
- 5) Gentile water baptism (Matthew 28:19), "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost," instead of the Jewish formula, "in the name of Jesus" (Acts 2:38). This baptism is a "FIGURE" of salvation and not a "SIGN" to Israel.
- 6) A baptism of fire for the lost in hell (Matthew 3:11, Revelation 20:14).
- 7) Saving baptism in this age; being the placing of the believer into the Body of Christ (1 Cor. 12:13). The Holy Spirit does this (Ephesians 4:1-5).

# II. THE SEVEN RESURRECTIONS

- 1) The physical resurrection of Jesus Christ (Matthew 28:1-6)
- 2) The resurrection of the Old Testament Saints (Matthew 27:52-53)
- 3) The resurrection of the believer's spirit (Ephesians 2:1-6)
- 4) The physical resurrection of believers (the church) at the rapture (I Thessalonians 4:16-17 & I Corinthians 15:49-55)
  - 5) The resurrection of the tribulation saints (Revelation 11:12).
  - 6) The resurrection of the nation of Israel (Ezekiel 37:10-11)
  - 7) The resurrection of the unsaved dead (Revelation 20:11-15)

# III. THE SEVEN JUDGMENTS

- 1) The judgment of sin at Calvary (1 Peter 3:18, 2 Corinthians 5:21, John 3:14,17-18)
- 2) The judgment of the believer in this age (believer himself judging his own sin) (1 Corinthians 11:31-32).
  - 3) The judgment seat of Christ (Romans 14:10, 2 Corinthians 5:10)

- 4) The judgment of Israel in the tribulation (Jeremiah 16:18, 30:4-7, Ezekiel 20:38, Hosea 2:6-15)
- 5) The judgment of the nations based on their treatment of Israel during the tribulation. (Matthew 25:32-41)
  - 6) The judgment of the unbeliever (Revelation 20:11-15)
  - 7) The judgment of angels (1 Corinthians 6:3)

## IV. THE SEVEN MYSTERIES

- 1) The mystery of the Incarnation (1 Timothy 3:16)
- 2) The mystery of the Indwelling Christ (Colossians 1:27)
- 3) The mystery of the Body of Christ (Ephesians 5:32, 3:1-5)
- 4) The mystery of the Blindness of Israel (Romans 11:25)
- 5) The mystery of Iniquity (2 Thessalonians 2:7). This deals with an individual man, the antichrist who will take over the ten nation, federated Common Market from Rome through the United Nations.
  - 6) The mystery of the Rapture (1 Corinthians 15:51)
- 7) The mystery of Babylon the Great (Revelation 17:1-5). This refers to a female demon who is personified in an apostate religious system whose "seat" is Rome.
