⇒ <u>Text</u>: I Thess. 5:18 & Eph. 5:20

⇒ <u>Intro</u>:

- We see from the Word of God that it is the will of God for the child of to give thanks in every thing.
 - The key words are every thing.
 - Not just the things and situations that makes us happy and joyous but also the things and situations that the flesh finds it difficult to thank the Lord for.
 - So, the revealed will of God for you and me is to "In every thing give thanks:..."
- On this Thanksgiving eve I want us to take a journey through some of the Pauline Epistles and looks at some of the things Paul was thankful for,
- ⇒ I. <u>God's Program of Grace</u> 1 Cor. 1:4
 - "I **thank my God** always on your behalf, for the **grace of God** which is given you by Jesus Christ;"
- ⇒ II. <u>God's Power</u> 1 Tim. 1:12
 - "And I **thank** Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath **enabled me**, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry;"
- \Rightarrow III. God's People 2 Thess. 1:3
 - "We are bound to **thank God** always for **you**, **brethren**, as it is meet, because that your faith groweth exceedingly, and the charity of every one of you all toward each other aboundeth;"
- ⇒ IV.<u>God's Provision</u> I Tim. 4:4
 - "For every creature of God is good, and nothing to be refused, if it be received with thanksgiving:"
 - "...He that eateth, eateth to the Lord, for he giveth God thanks;..." –
 Romans 14:6
- ⇒ V. God's Plan of Salvation 2 Cor. 9:15
 - "Thanks be unto God for his unspeakable gift."
