

## “The Word of God” Teachings about - SIN.

- There is none righteous, no, not one (Romans 3:10).
- For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God (Romans 3:23).
- If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us (1 John 1:10).
- If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us (1 John 1:8).
- Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law. (1 John 3:4).
- All unrighteousness is sin: and there is a sin not unto death (1 John 5:17).
- Whatsoever is not of faith is sin (Romans 14:23).
- Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin (James 4:17).

## “The Word of God” Teachings about - REDEMPTION.

- In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins (Ephesians 1:7).
- Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold...but with the precious blood of Christ (1 Peter 1:18-19).
- Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood, and hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father (Revelation 1:5-6).
- Without the shedding of blood is no remission of sins (Hebrews 9:22).
- Having made peace through the blood of his cross (Colossians 1:20).
- But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God...for by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified. (Hebrews 10:12,14).

## “The Word of God” Teachings about - SALVATION.

- Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved (Acts 16:31).
- But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God (John 1:12).
- He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God (John 3:18).
- He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life (John 3:36).
- Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost (Titus 3:5).
- For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God—not of works, lest any man should boast (Ephesians 2:8-9).
- Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus (Romans 3:24).
- Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth (Romans 10:4)

## “The Word of God” Teachings about - AFTERLIFE.

- For the wages of sin is death (Romans 3:23).
- And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt (Daniel 12:2).
- It is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment (Hebrew 9:27).
- And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God...the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books (Revelation 20:12).
- When the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven...taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ...Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord (2 Thessalonians 1:7-10).
- If thy foot offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter halt into life, than having two feet to be cast into hell. (Mark 9:45).

# Comparing “The Word of God” with Heresies, Teachings and Quotes Found in “Jehovah’s Witness” Writings

## “Jehovah’s Witness” Teachings about - GOD.

- God’s personal name is Jehovah (①, p.17).
- Only Jehovah is from everlasting to everlasting (②, p.486).
- Jesus Christ is not One God with the Father (②, p.485).
- There was a time when Jehovah was alone in universal space. All life and energy and thought were contained in him alone (③, p.25).
- The obvious conclusion is that Satan is the originator of the trinity doctrine (③, p.101).

## “Jehovah’s Witness” Teachings about - JESUS CHRIST.

- Not Jehovah God. He was the first son that Jehovah God brought forth (③, p.32).
- The First Creation by God (②, p. 282).
- Jesus Christ had a pre-human existence (③, p.34).
- Michael the archangel is no other than the only-begotten Son of God, now Jesus Christ (④, p.30).
- Jesus was born on October 1, in the year 2 B.C., of the virgin Mary (③, p.36).
- At baptism Jesus was anointed to become Messiah, or Jesus the Christ (③, p.38).
- He showed his subjection to God by humbling himself to a most disgraceful death on a cross (③, p.35).
- God raised him as a mighty immortal spirit Son (③, p.40).
- Christ was not raised in flesh, but with a spiritual body (②, p.426).

## “Jehovah’s Witness” Teachings about - THE HOLY SPIRIT.

- The Holy Spirit is the invisible active force of Almighty God that moves his servants to do his will (③, p.108).
- Holy Spirit is God’s Active Force, not a person (②, p.487).

## “Jehovah’s Witness” Teachings about - SIN.

- Sin is a falling short of God’s mark of perfection, transgression of His righteous law (②, p.456).
- Adam and Eve sinned by disobeying God’s plainly stated law (②, p.457).
- At death, Adam was to return to the dust, a return to non-existence (④, p.88).
- No descendant of Adam is free from sin; all inherit it from the first man (②, p.458).
- Everyone is born in sin (imperfect, with wayward tendencies) (②, p.456).
- Adam brought death not only upon himself, but also upon all of those descended from him (④, p.89).
- Perfect human life was lost with its rights and earthly prospects (③, p.114).

## “Jehovah’s Witness” Teachings about - REDEMPTION.

- The Bible plainly shows that 144,000 will share in heavenly glory, while the others will enjoy the blessings of life down here on earth (③, p.298).
- All who by reason of faith in Jehovah God and in Christ Jesus dedicate themselves to do God’s will and then faithfully carry out their dedication will be rewarded with everlasting life (③, p.298).
- An unnumbered crowd of faithful persons do not expect to go to heaven. They have been promised everlasting life on earth if they prove their faithfulness (③, p.231), by faith in Jehovah’s baptism, “provided...they abide in him, keeping their good conscience through faith and loyal service” (④, p.311).
- Armageddon survivors and the mass of humankind will find life here on earth amid paradise conditions (③, p.279).

## “Jehovah’s Witness” Teachings about - SALVATION.

- Adam is not included in those ransomed. He had perfect life, and this he deliberately forfeited (③, p.119).
- Jesus Christ laid down in sacrifice a perfect HUMAN LIFE, equal to that which Adam forfeited (⑤, p.39).
- The ransom, or redemptive price with which redemption is made, is “the man Christ Jesus” (③, p.113).
- His perfect human life with all its rights and prospects, was laid down in death, but NOT FOR SIN AND IN PUNISHMENT (③, p.116). In other words, Jesus was raised as a divine spirit creature.
- That which is redeemed or bought back is perfect human life with its rights and earthly prospects (③, p.114).
- The value of the perfect human life was now available for use on behalf of faithful men (③, p.116).
- Thus, makes possible general resurrection for mankind with opportunity for eternal life (②, p.411).
- It is a gross twisting of the Scriptures to throw Jesus’ words of John 3:3 to make them embrace all mankind (*The Watchtower*, Nov. 15, 1954, p.681). This “great crowd” of people is not “born again,” nor do they need to be “born again,” because they gain everlasting life on the earth) (*Ibid.*, p.682).

## “Jehovah’s Witness” Teachings about - AFTERLIFE.

- The doctrine of a burning hell where the wicked are tortured eternally after death cannot be true (③, p.99).
- A dead person is unconscious, inactive. The soul (entire being) itself is DEAD. (②, p.143).
- The millennial judgement day (the 1,000-year judgement day) will take place after Armageddon (③, pp.284-86).
- The final test will come by the loosing of Satan out of his restraint (at the end of the Millennium) (③, p.293).
- Those supporting Satan (at the end of the Millennium) will, with the Devil himself, be cast into the “lake of fire and sulphur. They are drowned in everlasting destruction (annihilated) and for them there is no resurrection” (③, p.270).
- All who reject the Kingdom message will be destroyed (③, p.190; ⑤, p.341).

## “The Word of God” Teachings about - GOD.

- In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth (Genesis 1:1).
- Know that the LORD he is God; there is none else beside him (Deuteronomy 4:35).
- God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth (John 4:24).
- For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus (1 Timothy 2:5).
- Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost (Matthew 28:19).
- And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him: And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. (Matthew 3:16-17).
- I have not spoken in secret from the beginning; from the time that it was, there am I (Isaiah 48:16).

## “The Word of God” Teachings about - JESUS CHRIST.

- In the beginning was the Word...and the Word was God. (John 1:1).
- His mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost (Matthew 1:18).
- Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel (Isaiah 7:14).
- God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory (1 Timothy 3:16).
- And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth (John 1:14).
- No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him (John 1:18).
- And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead (Romans 1:4).
- If Christ be not raised, your faith is vain (1 Corinthians 15:17).
- Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them. (Hebrews 7:25).
- This same Jesus...shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven (Acts 1:11; see also John 14:3; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18).

## “The Word of God” Teachings about - THE HOLY SPIRIT.

- When the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth...he shall testify of me. (John 15:26).
- And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment (John 16:8).
- When he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth (John 16:13).
- But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost...shall teach you all things (John 14:26).
- His Spirit that dwelleth in you (Romans 8:11).
- Be filled with the Spirit (Ephesians 5:18; see also 3:16; 1 Corinthians 3:16).
- But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his (Romans 8:9, 14,16.).
