- \Rightarrow I. A Man The Sinner v. 27
 - 1. His Position
 - Read v. 27
 - 2. His Tradition went to church
 - v. 27 "come to Jerusalem for to worship,..."
 - v. 28 **read**
 - 3. His Condition religious but lost
 - Read vs. 29-31
- ⇒ II. Some Man The Soul Winner v 31
 - o Read v. 31
 - 1. Following the Spirit got him to the right place
 - Read vs. 29-30
 - 2. Familiarity with the Scriptures gave him the right power
 - Read vs. 32-35
 - 3. Faithfulness in sharing gained the right profession
 - Read vs. 36-39
- ⇒ III. Some Other Man The Saviour vs. 34-35
 - Read vs. 34-35
- ⇒ Compare Isaiah. 53 where the Eunuch was reading
 - Phillip must have told him about:
 - 1. The Suffering Saviour Read Isa 53:3-5
 - 2. The Substitutional Sacrifice Read Isa. 53:5-6
 - 3. The Simple Salvation Read Romans 10:9-10
- ⇒ <u>Conclusion</u>:

 I wonder how many people, just like the Eunuch sit at home in our area reading the Word of God and as they did, had the same desire that someone would come by and shew them the way.
