The Lord Is A-B-L-E

Text: II Timothy 1:12\

Listed below are some ways the Lord is able to help His own:

I. A-bundantly Able

"Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think (Eph. 3:20).

- A. Abundant means: marked by great plenty; amply supplied: ABOUNDING; occurring in abundance: AMPLE" Webster.
- B. Many Christians depend on their own strength. They fail to trust God sufficiently.
- C. We must depend on the Lord daily. He is abundantly able to fortify us against the stresses of life (Phil. 4:13).

II B-ountifully Able

"And God is able to make all grace abound toward you..." (II Cor. 9:8).

- A. Bountiful means: "liberal in bestowing gifts or favors; given or provided abundantly" Webster.
- B. Many people are tightfisted with God and others. They want to keep everything for themselves.
- C. We cannot out give the Lord. We must be generous with Him and others. The Lord is bountifully able to supply all our needs (Phil. 4:19).

III. L-ovingly Able

"Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him (Heb. 7:25).

- A. Loving means: "AFFECTIONATE" Webster.
- B. God loved us so much that He gave His only Son Jesus Christ to die on the cross for our sins (John 3:16).
- C. To be saved we must come to God in repentance and faith, accepting the Lord Jesus Christ.

IV. E-ternally Able

"Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and for ever" (Heb. 13:8).

- A. Eternal means: "having infinite duration: EVERLASTING... PERPETUAL... "-Webster.
- B. Many people are changeable-here today and gone tomorrow. You never know where to find them.
- C. The Lord never leaves nor forsakes His own. He is eternally able to stand by us and sustain us (Ps. 55:22).
