WHY ARE CHRISTIANS LEFT IN THE WORLD?

⇒ Text: John 17:15

⇒ Intro:

- o Did it ever occur to you to wonder why Christians are left in the world?
 - In our Lord's High-Priestly prayer in John 17, we learn God's program for His own and why Christians are left in the world.

⇒ I. CHRISTIANS ARE NOT OF THIS WORLD.

- o 1. The redeemed are in the world, but not of the world.
 - Like the ship in the ocean is in it, but not of it John 17:16;
- o 2. In the New Testament the believer is warned against the world.
 - a. He is not to love the world I John 2:15.
 - b. He is not to fellowship with the world II Cor. 6:₱─-18.
 - c. He is not to fraternize with the world James 4:4.
- o 3. If we are not of the world, we will be hated by the world John 17:14.

⇒ II. THE PLACE OF CHRISTIANS IN THE WORLD.

- Tirst, our relationship is that of strangers I Peter 2:11.
- 2. Second, our ministry is that of ambassadors II Cor.5:20.
- o 3. Third, our service is that of witnessing Acts 1:8.

⇒ III. WHY CHRISTIANS ARE LEFT IN THE WORLD.

- o 1. First, we are left here for our own sakes.
 - We need to learn the lessons of faith, patience and endurance I Peter 1:7; Rom. 5:3-5.
- o 2. Second, we are left here for the world's sake.
 - We are left here actively to "rescue the perishing, care for the dying."

- o 3. Third, we are left here for Christ's sake.
 - He represents us perfectly before the Throne of Grace.
 - We are to represent Him here before a world in disgrace and degradation. lost and on its way to hell

⇒ IV. <u>CHRISTIANS ARE NOT GOING TO BE LEFT IN THE</u> WORLD ALWAYS.

- ⇒ There are at least four great truths suggested in John 17:24.
 - 1. First, we belong with Jesus because we are His. We are the Father's gift to the Son John 17:6, 9,11-12.
 - In our resurrection, He will fully claim His own.
 - o 2. Second, we see the Son's desire in John 17:24.
 - He wants us; we are His living choices, His inheritance in the Saints.
 - o 3. Third, we are to be with Him I Thess. 4:17.
 - o 4. Fourth, we are to be shown His eternal glory; love's glory.
 - Glory that He had with the Father before the world was Rev 1:5:3:14. John 17:5
