What Killed the Son of God?

- ⇒ **Text**: John 19:28-34
- ⇒ Intro:
 - o In the investigation of a death, one of the facts to be determine is "What was the cause."
 - Was it murder?
 - Was it a suicide?
 - Was it an accident?
 - Was it from natural causes?
 - o If we want to find out what caused the death of the Son of God, then we must first rule out what didn't kill him.
 - When we have ruled out all the things that didn't kill Jesus, we can begin to zero in on the real cause of death.
 - Let us notice "What Killed the Son of God."

 - Illustration: The wages of sin Romans 6:23
 - He paid the price for all of us John 19:30
- o B. Hell Jesus believes in hell.
 - He believes so strongly in Hell that He died to keep people from going there.
 - 2 Peter 3:9
- o C. Love God's love for fallen man.
 - John 3:16
 - Jeremiah 31:3
 - Romans 8:31-39
- ⇒ Conclusion:

- o The truth is, Jesus would have never died if it hadn't been for you!
 - He did it just so that you could enjoy His wonderful free salvation.
 - He loves you!
- My question is this, do you love Him?
 - Are you saved?
 - You can be if you will only call upon His name by faith.
- o If you are saved, then praise the Lord for His unspeakable gift to you!
